## 4) <u>DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A TAX</u> RATE OF \$0.56 PER \$100 VALUATION TO SUPPORT THE 2020-2021 BUDGET. (2ND READING OF ORD. 2020-15)

City Manager Parry said that there has been no changes to this ordinance adopting a tax rate of \$0.56 per \$100 valuation which supports the 2021 Fiscal Year Budget for the City of Gatesville and recommended approval of the second reading of Ordinance 2020-15.
