Why Should I Recycle My Used Cooking Oil

- The City of Gatesville has incurred significant operational and maintenance costs associated with Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG).
- Improper disposal of cooking oil does not only affect our city financially, but also you, the residents.
- Disposing of used cooking oil in an improper way, may lead to clogged or broken pipes that can cost thousands of dollars to repair.

Central Texas College Enactus partnered with the City of Gatesville to help residents recycle their used cooking oil FREE through one central location.

HOW:

- Let the used cooking oil or grease cool to a safe handling temperature.
- Once cooled, pour the used cooking oil into a jar or bottle with a lid.
- Take the oil to the Gatesville Recycling Center.
- Carefully pour the used cooking oil into the recycling bin.
- Recycle the oil container, or reuse it next time you fry food.
