#### JOB SUMMARY

The Building Maintenance Technician performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks related to the repair, upkeep, and preventive maintenance of city buildings, facilities, and equipment. This position ensures that facilities remain safe, functional, and well-maintained for employees and the public.

## **SUPERVISION**

Receives direct supervision from the City Secretary

#### **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**

- Perform routine inspections of buildings and facilities to identify repair and maintenance needs.
- Carry out preventive maintenance on HVAC systems, plumbing, electrical, and mechanical equipment.
- Repair or replace fixtures, lighting, flooring, doors, windows, and related building components.
- Perform minor plumbing, carpentry, painting, and electrical repairs.
- Assist in maintaining building safety systems, including fire alarms, extinguishers, and emergency exits.
- Monitor and maintain building supplies and materials; submit requests for replenishment.
- Respond to maintenance requests and emergencies in a timely manner.
- Keep accurate records of maintenance activities and work orders.
- Ensure compliance with applicable safety standards and building codes.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

- Two (2) years of experience in building maintenance, facilities operations, or related field preferred.
- Basic knowledge of carpentry, plumbing, electrical, HVAC, and general repair practices.
