Boys Bat Regulations for 2022:

For the 2022 season there is no limitation on length or diameter of the bat. BBCOR bats are allowed in all age groups. All other non-wood bats must be stamped USA Baseball or BPF 1.15 or less. Texas Teenage approved baseball or T-Ball bats may be used in 6U T-Ball.

Girls Helmet Regulations:

All girls divisions will require the NOCSAE approved facemask as required equipment for batting helmets.

Girls Bat Regulations for 2022:

For Girls Playing 6U T-Ball: Approved USA or USSSA Softball bats or T-Ball bats may be used. Approved USA Softball or USSSA Softball equipment including bats and gloves will be required in Girls 8U Coach Pitch, Girls 10U, Girls 12U and Girls 15U. Skills Day will be on March 5, 2022. Teams will be drafted by coaches March 21-26. Your assigned coach will contact you and set up practice times after the drafts are over.

Skills day is a fun day at the ballpark where players run through baseball/softball drills. Each child is given a rating during drills, and coaches use these to divide players evenly during the draft. Please understand, player ratings and the draft process are what determine team placement. All 7-15 year-old players are expected to attend. If your child cannot attend, he/she will randomly be placed on a team.

T-ball players do not need to attend Skills Day; they will be contacted after teams are drafted. Please arrive 15-20 minutes before your scheduled time and report to the concession stand for registration/sign-in. Your child will be assigned a number/sticker and sent to the correct field to warm up. Every child needs to bring a glove and batting helmet to skills day.
